NHFT Elections Information

October 31, 2018

- All NHFT members will be receiving a ballot with pertinent information concerning the NHFT election. The ballots are being sent via US mail to everyone's last known home address this week. Please be on the lookout for your ballot as they should be arriving within the next few days.
- If you do not receive a ballot or have spoiled your ballot you can request a replacement from either Head Trustee MarcAnthony Solli at 203-773-0266 or <u>caleb@mkelections.com</u>
- The NHFT protects the privacy of its member's information. We do <u>NOT</u> provide your personal email addresses or phone numbers as it is not required by Federal law nor appropriate for us to do so. Your privacy is important.
- Federal law requires that all candidates running for office be provided a onetime inspection of
 the membership list with home addresses. Neither copies nor photos of the list are permitted
 during this inspection period. However, the NHFT has agreed to provide this information
 (membership list and home addresses) to any candidate requesting it.
- Federal law requires a 15 day notification. The ballot mailing contains all pertinent information and serves as notification (per federal law). The NHFT's recent practice has voluntarily extended that voting window to 25 days to allow members additional time to return their ballots.
- Teachers will have a month to decide on a candidate, check the boxes on their ballot, and simply drop it in any US mailbox.
- Ballots must be received by December 4, 2018.
